Partner since 2022, 5-year award, \$850,000

- Hosted 50+ paid job shadows and nearly 200 paid summer interns
- Distributed 40 scholarships worth more than \$130,000



Partner since 2024, 2-year award, \$400,000

- Launched Medical Respite pilot, serving 15 individuals
- 250+ received medical stabilization services
- 47% participants improved health education and literacy



Partner since 2023, 3-year award, \$1,026,926

- Launched Second Chances Substance Use Disorder (SUD) pilot in Oct. 2023 which receives referrals from justice-involved individuals at the Skokie Courthouse
- 40+ assessed for SUD needs; 38 received and/or completed treatment

- Launched mobile Living Room vehicle which offers education and access to care in Aug. 2024
- Made 10+ appearances with more than 200 interactions with community members



Additional Community Programs

Annually, our system provides **primary, mental and dental care services** to over 3,900 Erie Evanston/Skokie Health Center under and uninsured clients.

Evanston Township High School Health Center, a school-based health clinic funded by Endeavor Health, sees an average of 1,000 Evanston Township High School students annually through over 1,600 visits.

In 2024, **Endeavor Health's Medication Assistance Program (MAP)**, which offers aid to patients who need help paying for prescription drugs, assisted 1,736 patients, filling 21,507 prescriptions valued at a cost of \$762,881.

The **Evanston Hospital Community Health Center**, which provides medical care to adults who lack private medical insurance, provided care for 2,982 patients through 7,418 visits in 2024.

The **Dental Center** at Evanston Hospital provided primary dental services and special consultations for 740 medically underserved adult patients in 2024.
