- Site of the first open-heart surgery in Lake County.
- Highland Park Hospital's state-of-the-art Family Birthing Center enables birthing patients to labor, deliver, recover and complete their postpartum period on the same floor. This optimized patient experience promotes continuity of care and ensures patients are supported by a consistent care team throughout their stay.
- Renovated and expanded inpatient Adolescent and Young Adult Behavioral Health wing expands access to behavioral health services.
- Highland Park, Evanston, Glenbrook and Skokie Hospitals are the primary teaching affiliate of the University of Chicago Pritzker School of Medicine.

- Nearly **\$842 million** contributed by Highland Park Hospital to the local economy through payroll, capital and other expenses.*
- Nearly **3,100 direct and indirect full-time jobs**, including 1,100+ directly at Highland Park Hospital, many of whom live, shop, spend and volunteer in the local community.*

Partner since 2022, 5-year award, \$2,429,000

- Served 28,000+ directly through counseling and case management
- 90%+ demonstrated a decrease in symptoms related to mental health concerns, such as depression, stress, etc.
- 90%+ reported increased access to resources to address social determinants of health



Partner since 2022, 5-year award, \$2,480,050

- Provided services to 6,400+, including health screening, point-of-care testing, vaccinations, and education sessions
- Projected to have help avoid 2,700+ ER visits, contributing to \$41.5 million in community cost savings
- Projected that the mobile clinic services helped avoid 1,441 ED visits, contributing to \$12.5 million in total cost savings/avoidance

Additional Community Programs

Erie HealthReach Waukegan formed a partnership with Endeavor Health to move their small hospital delivery team to Highland Park for the care of their high risk pregnancy patients. The partnership aligns both organizations' mission to provide community-focused, high-quality and affordable care with access to a team of OB/GYN physicians delivering 24/7 care at Highland Park Hospital's Labor, Delivery and Postpartum unit. Within the first year of this partnership, 314 expectant mothers from Erie HealthReach Waukegan delivered 316 infants.

In 2024, **Endeavor Health's Medication Assistance Program (MAP)**, which offers aid to patients who need help paying for prescription drugs, assisted 1,736 patients, filling 21,507 prescriptions valued at a cost of \$762,881.

Highland Park Hospital provides hot supper donations to **Catholic Charities** in Highwood three times each year.

The **Perinatal Family Support Center** provides a wide array of services free of charge to women and their families who experienced challenges related to pregnancy, birth, prematurity or perinatal loss. Services are provided in both inpatient and outpatient settings and include groups, sibling tours and a literacy program. The Perinatal Family Support Center responded to more than 1,500 referrals in FY24.
