Our hospital is an economic engine for the local economy:

- Nearly **\$670.7 million** contributed by Edward Hospital to the local economy through payroll, capital and other expenses.*
- More than **5,500 direct and indirect full-time jobs**, including 2,300+ directly at Edward Hospital, many of whom live, shop, spend and volunteer in the local community.*

Additional Community Programs

- Young Hearts for Life is the largest youth cardiac detection program in the United States aimed at preventing sudden cardiac death among young people. Endeavor Health's years-long partnership with Young Hearts for Life has facilitated crucial cardiac screenings in high schools in our communities. Endeavor Health's support enabled 12,105 screenings at 11 schools in 2023, resulting in the identification of 95 students with heart conditions.
- Our Business Intelligence and Analytics team developed health equity dashboards designed to identify and prioritize areas where health-related disparities may exist - leading to targeted interventions around culturally sensitive diabetes care and navigation.
- Endeavor Health offers dozens of free community wellness programs focused on health education topics including nutrition, stroke awareness, heart health and cancer prevention. Local educational outreach partners include the Tri-Town YMCA and C.W. Avery Family YMCA as well as various local public libraries.
- Endeavor Health is a proud sponsor and supporter of the DuPage Health Coalition, whose mission is to develop and sustain a system for managing the health of low-income and medically vulnerable residents of DuPage County. With support from the Endeavor Health Community Investment Fund, the DuPage Health Coalition has assisted 840+ individuals with 1,850+ medical claims, totaling \$3.7M in medical debt relief.

Community Investment Fund

The Community Investment Fund is a dedicated resource aimed at fostering health and wellness, addressing social determinants of health and creating equitable access to quality healthcare within our community. By strategically allocating these funds, we support local initiatives, partnerships and non-profit organizations that respond to priority community health needs. In addition to financial support, we serve as a convener for community organizations, fostering a collaborative environment where the collective impact of our partnerships is greater than the sum of their parts.
