- Comprehensive, acute care facility offering a variety of surgical specialties.
- Principal home to Kellogg Cancer Center & Mark R. Neaman Center for Personalized Medicine.
- The Evanston Hospital Community Health Center, which provides medical care to adults who lack private medical insurance, provided care for 3,164 patients through 12,816 visits in 2023.
- The Dental Center at Evanston Hospital provided primary dental services and special consultations for 3,442 medically underserved adult patients in 2023.
- Evanston and the other NorthShore Hospitals are the primary teaching affiliate of the University of Chicago.

Our hospital is an economic engine for the local economy:

- Nearly **\$1.9 billion** contributed by Evanston Hospital to the local economy through payroll, capital and other expenses.*
- More than **7,100 direct and indirect full-time jobs**, including +2,900 directly at Evanston Hospital, many of whom live, shop, spend and volunteer in the Evanston Community.*

Additional Community Programs

- Annually, our system provides primary, mental and dental care services to over 2,800 Erie Evanston/Skokie Health Center under and uninsured clients.
-  Evanston Township High School Health Center, a school-based health clinic funded by Endeavor Health, sees an average of 900 Evanston Township High School students annually through over 2,800 visits.
- In 2023, Endeavor Health's Medication Assistance Program (MAP), which offers aid to patients who need help paying for prescription drugs, assisted 1,751 patients, filling 21,097 prescriptions valued at a cost of \$917,497.
- Endeavor Health, in collaboration with Josselyn, has provided Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) to more than 600 community responders, as well as trainings focused on underrepresented/underresourced populations and community organizations. 16 instructors have been trained and provided with wraparound support to enable them to train other community responders.

Community Investment Fund

The Community Investment Fund is a dedicated resource aimed at fostering health and wellness, addressing social determinants of health and creating equitable access to quality healthcare within our community. By strategically allocating these funds, we support local initiatives, partnerships and non-profit organizations that respond to priority community health needs. In addition to financial support, we serve as a convener for community organizations, fostering a collaborative environment where the collective impact of our partnerships is greater than the sum of their parts.
