- The Endeavor Health Cardiovascular Institute at Glenbrook Hospital, opened in May 2024, is setting a new standard in heart care, offering a regional destination for advanced cardiovascular care from diagnosis to rehabilitation.
- During the COVID-19 pandemic Glenbrook became the COVID specialty hospital for the NorthShore system for two years.
- The communities Glenbrook serves have the highest concentration of long-term care facilities in our service area. We are proud of our ability to deliver sensitive and specialized care to the older adult population.
- Glenbrook and the other NorthShore Hospitals are the primary teaching affiliate of the University of Chicago.

Our hospital is an economic engine for the local economy:

- Nearly **\$819 million** contributed by Glenbrook Hospital to the local economy through payroll, capital and other expenses.*
- More than **3,100 direct and indirect full-time jobs**, including 1,300+ directly at Glenbrook Hospital, many of whom live, shop, spend and volunteer in the local community.*

Additional Community Programs

- Endeavor Health's summer/fall pop up farmers markets provided opportunities for staff to purchase fresh produce from a local farm as part of employee well-being and vitality. At each market, a local food pantry is provided a stipend to shop for fresh produce and bring back for their community/client distribution. Local pantry partner: Northfield Township Food Pantry.



- The Perinatal Family Support Center provides a wide array of services free of charge to women and their families who experienced challenges related to pregnancy, birth, prematurity or perinatal loss. Services are provided in both inpatient and outpatient settings and include groups, sibling tours and a literacy program. The Perinatal Family Support Center responded to more than 1,500 referrals in FY23.

- In 2023, Endeavor Health's Medication Assistance Program (MAP), which offers aid to patients who need help paying for prescription drugs, assisted 1,751 patients, filling 21,097 prescriptions valued at a cost of \$917,497.

Community Investment Fund

The Community Investment Fund is a dedicated resource aimed at fostering health and wellness, addressing social determinants of health and creating equitable access to quality healthcare within our community. By strategically allocating these funds, we support local initiatives, partnerships and non-profit organizations that respond to priority community health needs. In addition to financial support, we serve as a convener for community organizations, fostering a collaborative environment where the collective impact of our partnerships is greater than the sum of their parts.

Removing critical transportation barriers to community-based services for children and families at risk and in need, including healthcare, counseling, job training and support groups



1-year award, \$300,000

Build out a new pantry space for improved access and efficiency, including: additional storage space; dedicated work areas for volunteers; dedicated check-in and waiting room spaces; and ADA-compliant entrance, aisles, and bathrooms



2-year award, \$500,000

Purchase and renovate a new building to expand its trauma-informed services, increase staff and volunteer capacity, and implement support groups for vulnerable communities. The new space will also feature a modernized training room for presentations to partners, positioning the building as a healing center for the community
