- Performs more orthopaedic surgeries than any other hospital in Illinois.
- Established in 1963, Skokie Hospital also provides patients access to a vast network of outpatient clinical resources, from multispecialty physician offices to cardiac imaging, radiology and gastrointestinal services—and an Emergency Department.
- Skokie and the other NorthShore Hospitals are the primary teaching affiliate of the University of Chicago.

## \$35.4M

Our hospital is an economic engine for the local economy:

- Nearly **\$651.4 million** contributed by Skokie Hospital to the local economy through payroll, capital and other expenses.\*
- More than **2,500 direct and indirect full-time jobs**, including 1,000+ directly at Skokie Hospital, many of whom live, shop, spend and volunteer in the local community.\*

## Additional Community Programs

- Endeavor Health's support for the Village of Skokie Farmers Market helps connect low-income consumers (LINK card holders) with fresh local produce. Endeavor Health matches LINK card purchases at Farmers Markets dollar-for-dollar for the purchase of fresh produce.
- Turning Point Behavioral Health Care Center's innovative "The Living Room" project provides psychiatric respite care for patients dealing with mental health issues. The unique program, supported by Skokie Hospital, uses peer counselors (adults in recovery from their own mental health challenges) and reports a 98% success rate in keeping in-crisis patients out of hospital emergency rooms.
- In 2023, Endeavor Health's Medication Assistance Program (MAP), which offers aid to patients who need help paying for prescription drugs, assisted 1,751 patients, filling 21,097 prescriptions valued at a cost of \$917,497.
- Annually, our system provides primary, mental and dental care services to over 2,800 Erie Evanston/Skokie Health Center under and uninsured clients.



## Community Investment Fund

The Community Investment Fund is a dedicated resource aimed at fostering health and wellness, addressing social determinants of health and creating equitable access to quality healthcare within our community. By strategically allocating these funds, we support local initiatives, partnerships and non-profit organizations that respond to priority community health needs. In addition to financial support, we serve as a convener for community organizations, fostering a collaborative environment where the collective impact of our partnerships is greater than the sum of their parts.

- Launched Second Chances Substance Use Disorder (SUD) pilot in Oct. 2023 which receives referrals from justice-involved individuals at the Skokie Courthouse

Partner since 2024, 3-year award, \$665,000


- Provided accessible, affordable, culturally sensitive primary, preventive and specialty medical, dental and behavioral healthcare to under-resourced, un/underinsured community members

- Purchased two vans to be attached to the new housing complex for female victims of human trafficking to reduce transportation barrier for healthcare, counseling, job training, and more
