Inpatient = Inpatient (Inpt) Hematology (Heme) or Inpatient Oncology (Onc) – Inpatient time will include the combined time on inpatient service and inpatient consults. Hematology is separate from oncology and inpatient months will be split, with ~ 2:1 hematology: oncology reflecting service size

Palliative Care/ Blood Bank- 2 week on combined inpatient and outpatient palliative care. A separate 2 weeks in blood bank/ apheresis

Nsg + Pharmacy / Surg Path – This rotation will be 2 weeks spent with outpatient treatment nurses and outpatient oncology pharmacists. And then a separate 2 weeks of Surgical Pathology

Medical Genetics/ Molecular Pathology- This rotation will be 2 weeks of outpatient Medical Genetics and then 2 weeks of Molecular Pathology

Ambulatory (Amb)- Will consist of 4 half day clinics, (separate from 2 ongoing continuity clinics (see below)) to cover specialties not as well covered in continuity clinics as well as to meet individual fellow's goals).

Rad Onc/ Neuro Onc- Will refer to 2 weeks with Radiation Oncology and then 2 separate weeks of Neuro Oncology

Allo Transplant – Will be one month at Site 3 Allo Transplant plus cell therapy. Additional elective months will be available ** Note during inpatient oncology and hematology months at Site 1, fellows will also be exposed to and caring for autologous transplant and cell therapy patients

Elective – Includes those listed below, second rotations through scheduled specialties, or “other”. Most all will be at site 1 or 2. Most will be outpatient thus indicated as 100% outpatient but an inpatient elective may be chosen in which case outpatient % will be less than 100%

Vacation – Includes 4 Weeks of vacation

Gyn Onc – Outpatient and Inpatient Gynecological Oncology (plus O.R. as desired)

Research – Defined broadly and may include lab, translational, retrospective or clinical research; Quality Improvement; Leadership or other scholarly pursuits

Research/Elective- Fellow may choose additional research months or additional elective (and thus research is noted as 80% but may be 0-80%)

Palliative Care/ Coag – 2 weeks with inpatient and outpatient palliative care/and 2 weeks of coag lab and heme lab

Continuity Clinic will include ½ day per week for 36 months in benign + malignant hematology; Plus 36 continuity oncology months to include 6 month blocks of: 1.) Breast, 2.) Thoracic, 3.) Genitourinary; 4.) Gastrointestinal; 5.) Head and Neck/ Cutaneous/Sarcoma; plus 6.) “other” or repeat
